2023 ASIA PACIFIC SNOOKER CHAMPIONSHIPS CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The Championship will be conducted under the APSBF Championship Conditions. Nominees must be a financial member of their country of representation.
- 2. WPBSA Main Tour Players are not permitted to play in this event.
- 3. NZ Based players must register and financial with their NZ Regional Association before entering both events.
- 4. Entries will only be received on the official ONLINE Entry form and must include the ONLINE Entry Fee to be paid by the closing date.
- 5. All international entries will be accepted on receipt of ONLINE Entry Form and copy of flight details. Players can pay their entry fee on arrival at the Championship.
- 6. Tournament standard dress is required: Long sleeve predominately plain coloured shirts buttoned at the wrist, bow ties and dark colour dress shoes must be worn for all matches. No sports style shoes, sandals, or boots will be allowed. Waistcoats are required for knockout stages. Failure to comply with this condition may result in forfeiture of the game. Note that bow ties must be worn standard neck ties are not acceptable.
- 7. Note: Referees will be provided for the Round Robin matches, with roving Referees on hand to assist. Referees will be provided for Knock Out matches . For the 6 Red Championship, Referees will be provided for the for the whole event.
- 8. All players to report to the Tournament Director 15 minutes before their scheduled starting time and be ready to play at that time.
- 9. This entry form constitutes part of the conditions of entry. Changes may be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
- 10. Players may be subject to drug testing as per the APSBF Drugs Policy pursuant to Championship Conditions 15.1.
- 11. INDEMNITY: All participants enter at their own risk. Neither the club, nor sponsor, nor organizers shall be liable for any loss, injury or misadventure however arising.
